



Technical Rehearsal

A Tech Rehearsal is essentially a dance class on stage. We do this so the dancers can get more accustomed to being on stage. This way they have the chance to practice moving on and off stage and find their exact spot that they will be in during the recital. This is also good because it allows dancers to practice on stage without the stress of having their costumes on and the other classes present. This is a very important class time! Attendance is highly recommended if your child is planning on participating in the recital. Please plan accordingly, I know it is going to be a busy week, but it will be worth it!

During Tech Rehearsal, students should not wear their dance costume as that is for the dress rehearsal and recital only. Dance costumes can be distracting, plus we want to keep the costumes in good shape. Students should wear their regular dance attire. It is not mandatory for students to have their stage hair and make-up done for this Rehearsal. If parents wish to get some extra practice, stage hair and make-up is permitted.

Parents are welcome to watch both the Tech and Dress Rehearsal. However please don't bring a large crowd. During the Tech rehearsal I will need to communicate with the recital staff to get all of the technical things situated such as lights, music, and curtain calls. It is very difficult to do this when I have to speak over an audience. It also makes it more uncomfortable for our students to focus if their friends and family are hanging out in the auditorium. There is a lobby where people can wait in while the Rehearsal takes place.

Absolutely No Food or Beverages are allowed in the High School's Performing Arts Center. This is Eudora School's policy, and we will expect everyone (even parents) to abide by this, so we can use the facility in future years.
